Culver City and its Fire Department invite you to join the Team! Become a member of Culver City’s emergency preparedness team and make a difference in the event of a disaster.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The training is free and available to residents of Culver City and those who work in Culver City. Participants must be a minimum of 16 years of age. (Non-Culver City residents may also attend if they live in an area with a CERT Program.)

WHAT’S INVOLVED? WHERE IS THE TRAINING?

Firefighters and CERT Instructors will train you to help your family & neighbors by teaching you how to be better prepared first. There are four class sessions. Approximately 22 hours of training include Intro to Disaster Response, Medical Operations, Fire Suppression, Disaster Psychology, and Light Search & Rescue. The training takes place right in Culver City at the Fire Training Facility at 9275 Jefferson Boulevard.

HOW DO YOU SIGN UP?

Commit yourself to helping yourself and others. Complete the tear-off and return by mail or in person to CERT, c/o Culver City Fire Department, City Hall, 9770 Culver Boulevard, Culver City, CA 90232. You must register for the class **BEFOREHAND**—walk-ins cannot be accommodated. *Classes limited to 25 to allow for plenty of “hands-on training”.*
